## Summer Position Available *Development & Outreach Assistant (full-time, temporary)*

Persistence Theatre invites applications from eligible applicants (ages 15-30) for the position of **Development & Outreach Assistant**. This is an eight (8) week position at 30 hours per week, paid at the rate of \$11.40 per hour. It is funded through the Government of Canada's Canada Summer Jobs program and applicants should be located within the metropolitan St. John's, NL area.

Reporting to, and working closely with, the Producing Artistic Director, the successful applicant will be responsible for a range of duties related to the revenue generation activities of a non-profit professional feminist theatre company. Preference will be given to a person identifying as female.

### **Duties:**

- Assist in community relations, fundraising & donation acquisitions.
- Research potential new funding partners.
- Assist with maintaining company database.
- Research audience trends & new ways to engage audience/participants.
- Other related duties as assigned.

### **Qualifications:**

- Must be aged 15-30 at the start date of employment, and be legally able to work in Canada.
- Should have studied and/or have experience in arts administration, business management, marketing, fundraising, communications, or a related field.
- Superior written and oral communications skills are necessary.
- Understanding and support of the precepts of feminism.
- Demonstrated ability to work both as part of a group and independently.

Experience with marketing, surveying, database maintenance, fundraising, and/or donor research will be considered assets.
