

PerSIStence Theatre is hiring a **marketing assistant** to assist our ongoing operations.

Working with the producing artistic director, this position can be tailored to the specific skills and interests of the successful applicant and may include work in the following areas:

- Writing and editing
- Working with volunteers and community partners
- Research
- Participating in Marketing and Communications activities, including
 - Web and social media
 - Media relations
 - Electronic newsletters
 - Podcasts

This is a 18-week/288 hour contract, (ideally) starting Monday May 17, 2021 and ending on Friday, September 17, paying a salary based on \$15/hour x 16 hours per week for a total contract gross fee of \$4,320.

This position is subsidized through the Canada Summer Jobs, and as such applicants must be:

- between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment
- be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident, or person to whom refugee protection has been conferred under the *Immigration and Refugee Protection Act* for the duration of the employment
- have a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment and be legally entitled to work in Canada in accordance with relevant provincial legislation and regulations
