Working with the producing artistic director, this position will tailor to the specific skills and interests of the successful applicant and could include work in the following areas:

This is a 280 hour contract, paying a salary based on \$15.60/hour for a total contract gross fee of \$4,368.

Preference will be given to members of the Indigenous community in NL and to those who identify as women.*

This position is subsidized through the Canada Summer Jobs program, and as such applicants must be between 15 and 30 years of age at the start of the employment. Please state that you meet this criteria clearly in your application.
